Search the catalogue for a journal

If the journal you're looking for is not in this list you will need to search the State Library's catalogue to see if the library holds the journal.

You can search the catalogue from the State Library's home page under **Search our collections**.



Make sure you search for the title of the **journal**, not the title of the article you want to read.

The catalogue entry for the journal will look like this.

Note the **call number** (or location) of the journal. You will need this to fill in a Stack Request Slip to order the volume.

Order the journal

Most journals are kept in stack so you will need to fill in a Stack Request Slip to order the volume you need. Hand in your stack slip at the Request Desk. It will take library staff about 15 or 20 minutes to retrieve the journal for you.
